Nursing Entrance Examination, 2024 conducted by SSUHS on dated 02.06.2024 by fulfilling the Admission and Minimum Eligibility Criteria.

Please Note:

- Candidates are listed as per the marks obtained in M.Sc Nursing Entrance Examination, 2024 conducted by SSUHS.
- Candidates will be called as per merit list without categorization of reservation as Unreserved Candidates.
- The reserved seats will subsequently be filled by the respective quota.
- Any seats remaining vacant (if candidates of the reserved quota are not available) will be opened to general category candidates.
- In case of candidate obtaining same marks in entrance examination, then Inter-se-Merit shall be determined on the basis of following criteria-
 - A candidate who has higher aggregate marks in qualifying exam B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination will rank higher to a candidate who has less aggregate marks.
 - If the marks obtained in B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination are also same, then preference will be given to the older candidate over the younger one.
 - If the candidates' ages are the same, then the candidate with the higher PCBE aggregate marks in 10+2 will be ranked higher than the candidate with the lower PCBE aggregate marks.
