This is for information of all concerned that 'Result of selected candidates for admission into M.Sc. Nursing (Oncology Nursing) Course 2024-2025 at Dr. B. Borooah Cancer Institute, Guwahati' declared vide notification No. BCCI-TMC/Aca/Pt-III/341/2024 dated: 02.08.2024 **stands cancelled** based on the decision taken by the selection committee.

The selection committee has decided to fulfill the M.Sc. Nursing seats as per the initial admission notification vide no. BCCI-TMC/Aca/Pt-III/176/2024 dated: 13.06.2024 and it will be done purely based on Merit as per the Result of Common M.Sc. Nursing Entrance Examination, 2024 conducted by SSUHS on dated 02.06.2024 by fulfilling the Admission and Minimum Eligibility Criteria.

**Please Note:**

- Candidates are listed as per the marks obtained in M.Sc Nursing Entrance Examination, 2024 conducted by SSUHS .
- Candidates will be called as per merit list without categorization of reservation as Unreserved Candidates.
- The reserved seats will subsequently be filled by the respective quota.
- Any seats remaining vacant (if candidates of the reserved quota are not available) will be opened to general category candidates.
- In case of candidate obtaining same marks in entrance examination, then Inter-se-Merit shall be determined on the basis of following criteria-
  - A candidate who has higher aggregate marks in qualifying exam – B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination will rank higher to a candidate who has less aggregate marks.
  - If the marks obtained in B.Sc. Nursing/ Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination are also same, then preference will be given to the older candidate over the younger one.
  - If the candidates' ages are the same, then the candidate with the higher PCBE aggregate marks in 10+2 will be ranked higher than the candidate with the lower PCBE aggregate marks.
