1 YEAR SERVICE BOND COMPULSORY-

Student would be bound to pay Rs.10 Lakhs + applicable GST, if he/she fails to complete the residency tenure of 3 years and have to pay Rs.50 lakhs + applicable GST if he/she fails to serve the bond of one year after passing the DM /M.Ch. course.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS THAT on this day of

.....(hereinafter called collectively as “Sureties” other part,

Hereby jointly and severally bind ourselves and our respective heirs executors and administrators to pay to Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute (hereinafter referred as “**BBCI**”),its successors and assignees, on demand the sum of Rs.50,00,000/ + GST - Rs.10,00,000/- + GST (Rupees Fifty lakhs or Rupees Ten Lakhs plus GST) as the case may be and as hereinafter contained together with interest thereon from the date of demand till the date of payment, in the event of breach of the conditions by the said PG Student as set out below.

2.0)WHEREAS, the P.G student has applied to the Centre against open advertisement for admission to the PG degree in DM/M.Ch course conducted by the Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute for imparting training in Superspeciality degree viz.DM/M.Ch (hereinafter referred to as PG course).

3.0) The said PG student has agreed to execute this bond with two sureties aforesaid and with such conditions as herein under written.

Now the conditions to be observed and complied with by the said PG student and their sureties are as under:

a)The PG student has voluntarily accepted admission to the PG course for the period from.....(3 years).The PG student has clearly understood that he will be required to sign a bond for completion of the residency tenure for the period of 3 years and binds himself that he will complete the course, failing which he would be bound to pay Rs.10,00,000/- + GST (Rupees Ten Lakhs Plus GST) to Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute forthwith on demand by Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute together with the interest thereon from the date of default, at the rate prescribed of Government loans and prevailing on the date of demand or if payment is made in the country other than India, the equivalent amount of the currency of that country converted at the official rate of exchange between that country and India. This condition shall however, not be applicable to the candidate who is resigning before the final round of selection conducted by MCC for Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute on prescribed dates decided by these Authorities.

b)The PG student clearly understands that in the event the said PG student continues the course for the entire duration of 3 years and on his successful completion, he is required to serve for a minimum period of one year at the Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute and he will be paid consolidated stipend as may be prescribed at that point of time and in any case it will not be less than the consolidated stipend paid to him/her on the date of qualifying in the said degree. The PG student further binds himself along with the sureties that in the event he/she fails to serve as stated herein before at Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute as aforesaid for the said minimum period of one year, he will be liable to pay the sum of Rs.50,00,000/- + GST (Rupees Fifty Lakh plus GST only) as a breach of condition. Student will not be allowed to leave during Service Bond period for any reason (job opportunity or for further studies).Student under Bond cannot apply for any residency program, Fellowship program (FNB/NBE). Students on Bond, if selected for State or Central Govt service then they have to take permission for joining period after completion of bond period.

4.0) The sureties viz

(i).....(ii).....do hereby jointly and severally covenant with BBCI that if the said PG student makes default in payment of the sum of Rs.10,00,000/- + GST (Rupees ten lakh Plus GST only)/Rs.50,00,000/- + GST (Rupees fifty Lakh plus GST only) as the case may be as mentioned herein above or any part thereof, together with interest thereon from the date of demand at Government rates for the time being in force on Government loans, the sureties shall on demand and without murmur pay to

BBCI the said sum of Rs.10,00,000/- + GST (Rupees ten lakh plus GST only)/Rs.50,00,000/-+ GST (Rupees Fifty Lakhs plus GST only) as the case may be together with interest thereon from the date of default at the rate levied for Government loan and prevailing on the date of demand and that the liability of sureties hereunder shall not in any way be affected by any time waiver or indulgence of any nature of any kind whatsoever given, made or shown by BBCI to or in favour of the said PG Student. The sureties hereby agree that to all intents and purposes the liability of the sureties for the payment of all the sum of money under this agreement shall be deemed to be that of the principal parties each of the sureties, jointly and severally.

5.0) Notwithstanding anything herein contained ,it shall be lawful for BBCI to terminate the tenure of the Residency of the course, if his/her progress is found Unsatisfactory by BBCI or any violations of the rules/regulations, as applicable or for the other reason of which BBCI shall be sole judge, and in that event the said amount of Rs.10,00,000/- + GST (Rupees Ten Lakhs plus GST Only) as contained in Para 3(a) above shall become payable by said P.G Students/sureties immediately and the said PG Student shall be bound to pay the same and if he/she fails to do so, the sureties shall be jointly and severally responsible to pay the same to the centre on demand.

6.0) It is expressly understood by the said PG Student and the sureties herein that the Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute shall be entitled to recover the said sum of Rs.10,00,000/-+ GST /Rs.50,00,000/- + GST as the case may be in the event of default of their payment on demand and that Dr.B.Borooah Cancer Institute shall be entitled to initiate civil/criminal proceedings as may be required at the cost, risk and consequences of the said PG student and the sureties thereon.

This agreement shall in all respects be governed by the laws of India for the time being in force and the courts in Guwahati shall have exclusive jurisdiction to try the dispute and adjudicate between the parties.
